Pennine Events are proud to present the 2011 Cottages4you Pendle Predator Cycle Challenge (formerly National Cyclo-Sportive / Pendle Pedal / Bowland Beast).

Now renamed to fully reflect the true beauty and remoteness of the route along with the ferocity of the challenge, the former Pendle Pedal is now in its 5th year. This event will once again feature 2 challenging distances – 175km or 100km – neither for the faint hearted! It includes many of the climbs tackled by pro riders on the Tour of Britian, Kellogg's Tour and Tour of Lancashire races and last year's National Road Race Championships.

The Routes - What would be your chosen route?

Whether you know the area or not you are in for a treat in one of the most scenic and minimal traffic areas in England. You'll conquer many challenging climbs and descents that are renowned throughout cycling such as the magnificent Barley Fell, Waddington Fell, Nick O' Pendle, Bowland Knotts, the Lune Valley, Trough of Bowland, Chipping and Longridge Fell. Both routes will start and finish at the Rolls Royce Sports Ground, Barnoldswick.

The road routes are signed and marshalled with full support services including mechanics, first aid and pick-up vehicles. Entrants will be given a timing chip so all times can be recorded and published. There will be four FREE refreshment stations on the full route and two FREE refreshments stations on the mini route.

Pendle Predator 175km (110miles) 3122m of ascent!

Plenty of hills and thrills. You'll get plenty of practice changing gears and sweeping down rolling hills on this large anti-clockwise sweep around the remote north-east Lancashire countryside. It includes Barley Fell, Waddington Fell, Bowland Knotts, the Lune Valley, Trough of Bowland, Chipping, Longridge Fell and the Nick O' Pendle!

Pendle Mini Predator 100km (60miles) 1940m of ascent!

Based on the full tour but taking a short-cut across from Slaidburn to miss out the northern section. It still includes Barley Fell, Waddington Fell, Chipping, Longridge Fell and the Nick O' Pendle!
